From installing energy efficient light fixtures to major mechanical equipment, the Program provides cash incentives that reduce the initial cost of energy efficiency projects. These equipment and system upgrades improve your efficiencies, lower lifetime operating costs, and reduce your business's impact on the environment.*

Technical support and cash incentives are offered to owners and design teams for new construction, major renovation, and building addition projects. These incentives are offered for new energy-efficient equipment installed in these projects and for technical assistance during the building design phase.

**Equipment Incentives** – Cash incentives for these projects are calculated using Maryland State Building Codes as the baseline which is different than the incentives offered for existing buildings. Cash incentives available for the purchase of new equipment can include:

- » Chillers
- » Commercial Refrigeration & Kitchen Equipment
- » Custom Projects
- » Design-Based Lighting
- » Lighting Controls
- » Packaged HVAC Units
- » Specialized Controls

**Comprehensive Design Support** – In addition to equipment incentives, the Program offers the services of energy engineering professionals who will work with the customer and the design team from the conceptual design stage of the project. The Program provides guidance from energy efficiency experts; technical assistance in analysis of energy-efficient design options; and help in identifying the best measures and designs to use. We offer cash incentives to the customer's own design team for design work or analysis necessary to accommodate program recommendations. The Comprehensive Building Design incentive rules and processes are structured to support participation in the LEED rating system, if the customer so desires.

For the LEED Track, the energy baseline will be the LEED basic requirements. Incentives for this track will only be for improvements exceeding the LEED baseline.

The non-LEED Track will use an energy baseline determined by the prevailing building codes.

**On-going Building and Process Performance Program** – Once the energy efficient equipment and controls are installed, the next step is to ensure your employees are trained and processes are in place to continue reducing your operating costs and increasing your energy efficiency.
